TEACHER WORKSHOP

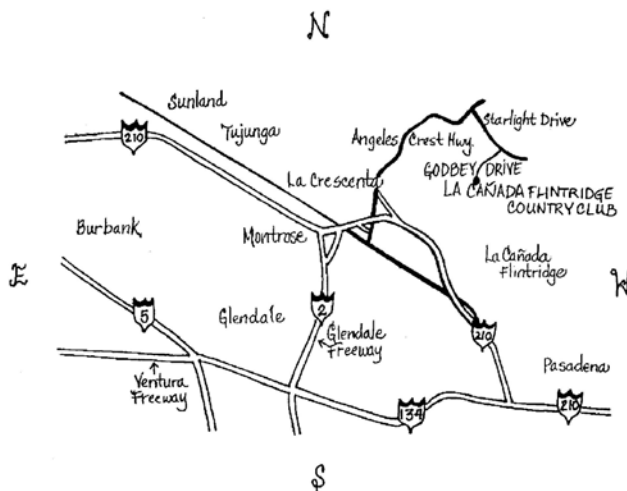

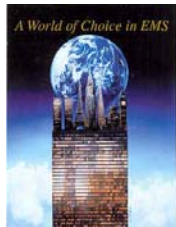
