The meeting was scheduled to begin at 3:00 p.m. at Southern California Edison in the SCLTC Room, 6060 Irwindale, California 91702.

Unfortunately, a majority of the Officers and Board members were unable to attend. In an effort to accomplish what was intended at the meeting, Michael Burke requested the officers provide information on the scheduled agenda items by email.

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## J. MICHAEL BURKE - PRESIDENT

### Key Topics:

- Michael Burke emailed his report and sent his congratulations to all of the new Chapter Officers and Directors. He requested all respective pertinent data, communications, and materials be transferred to the new Officers.
- He stated timing was important due to the tight schedule for the Installation Dinner, the Planning Meeting, and the Budget Meeting.
- Michael Burke listed his recommendations for the new Board. He recommended continuing the format for Attendance and Reception as well as

  - Mike recommended the Chapter continue to follow the national theme in order to create more enthusiasm. He felt this will result in greater attendance and participation.
  - He recommended continuing the dynamic programs and stated the Technical and Main Programs were the best in recent years. He suggested a committee be established with the President-Elect making the final decisions.
  - Mike recommended condensing Sol\*Air with the format including more technical profiles. He suggested charging members for hard copy mailings.
  - It was recommended to incorporate more interesting information in the Roster and include a creative front with the theme on the back cover.
  - He stated to continue expansion of the website, however include more technical content.
  - Mike recommended continuing to improve upon financial reporting with firm procedures in requisitioning, purchasing, and distribution policies.
